

Whistleblowing Advice

Have you got concerns about someone's safety?

Are you worried about speaking up?

Clergy, lay staff and volunteers are encouraged to raise concerns where:

- the law may have been broken
- · Diocesan policies and procedures may have been breached
- · there are concerns of a safeguarding nature

Clergy, lay staff and volunteers should initially raise any concerns with the most relevant of the following vicar, line manager, volunteer co-ordinator, Parish Safeguarding Officer, Archdeacon or Bishop.
